

## Assembly instructions

- Print the .pdf file onto white 200gsm (grams per square metre) A4 card stock at 100% on best print setting.
- Lightly spray with picture varnish (available from art supplies stores) to fix the ink on the paper.
- Score broken lines and fold dashed lines towards back (mountain fold) and dot-dashed lines towards the front (valley fold).
- Transfer position of the two rows of "bolts" on part [1] to the back.
- Cut the seat part [1] on the shorter sides only. Roll over a cylindrical object (such as a pencil) with printed side out, then fold along the scored lines.
- Unfurl flat and trim the longer sides, then restore shape
- Fold the bench legs [2] and ends [3] along dashed lines and glue each piece back to back.
- Cut away as little or as much of the grey area as you please.
- Apply glue to the edges of part [2] first and position them underneath part [1] in line with the "bolts". Make sure the valley folds of part [1] sit firmly in the corners of part [2] and that the legs are square.
- When dry, apply glue to the edge at the end of part [1] and carefully position it onto part [3]. This is a little bit tricky, so take your time. Repeat for other side and make sure legs are square.
- Using a felt tip pen, colour in any white areas such as cut edges and folds. We recommend a Pantone Warm Grey No. 7 for this purpose. Do not use black, as it is too harsh.
